

## Guidelines for IQ Biology Conference/Travel Funds Application

## *Eligibility:*

- 1) Only current IQ Biology students may apply.
- 2) The student MUST be one of the following:
  - a. Attending a conference outside their primary discipline;
  - b. Presenting research done outside of the primary discipline of the conference;
  - c. Attending an interdisciplinary conference; or
  - d. Visiting another PI's lab with the goal of interdisciplinary study.
- 3) A presentation\*must be made (poster or talk accepted at conference, talk to lab/department at visiting institution).
- 4) Upon return a 250-500 word blog-post must be written for publication on the BioFrontiers Website.
- 5) The application must be submitted to <a href="mailto:Amber.McDonnell@colorado.edu">Amber.McDonnell@colorado.edu</a> at least 6 weeks prior to date of travel. Additionally, applicants must allow one month for applications to be reviewed and for funding decisions to be made. Not all applications will necessarily be accepted.

## Award Description:

1) Funds can be distributed in any year, but students may receive funds only once during their graduate studies.

2) Funds can be used to cover the cost of travel, food, materials, or registration fees.

3) Travel expenses, food, and non-alcoholic beverages will be reimbursed up to \$1000. Receipts <u>must</u> be submitted along with a form for reimbursement.

<sup>\*</sup> In some instances, the presentation requirement may be waived. Please see the application or contact IQ Biology staff for details.
